Off Campus Learning

Dear Parents & Carers,

As required due to the current situation, St Peter's will provide Off Campus Learning (OCL) for Weeks 1 & 2 of Term Three, commencing Monday 19 July.

Students will be required to access Seesaw (Prep - Year 6) and Google Classroom (Years 3 - 6) from a device within your home. If you do not have access to a laptop or desktop device, please call the office to arrange a suitable time to collect a school device to use at home. Please note that phones and tablets are not conducive to OCL.

Teachers will upload a weekly overview of learning experiences by 10am each Monday morning, and will release activities daily on either of these platforms. Learning activities will be a balance of 'on' and 'off' screen tasks, and will generally expect students to participate in two - four hours of intentional learning per day, based on their respective age and what is achievable for your family situation.

Students will also have continued access to a variety of digital platforms. Please see your child's diary for login information.

A new addition this year is the opportunity for students to connect daily with their teacher through Zoom for a pastoral check in, prayer and clarification as needed. Please note the following requirements for students in using Zoom:

ZOOM Etiquette for students

- *Ensure an adult knows you are on a Zoom call with your teacher*
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- *Dress appropriately (school sports uniform & house shirt)*
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- *Use your full name when signing in*
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- *Be aware of your background, sit still in the same spot, avoid bright lights*
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- *Mute until it is your turn to talk*
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ZOOM information will be included on the Weekly Overview, uploaded to Seesaw.

Should you need to communicate with your child's teacher in regards to off campus learning, please utilise email as a first point of contact. The teacher's email address will be listed on the provided weekly overview. Teachers will respond to emails during normal working hours only, and we thank you for your understanding of this.

Further information will be provided to families, should off campus learning be required for further weeks.
